Vegan Chocolate Cake



Ingredients

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- 1 ½ cups of self raising flour
- 1 ¼ cups of caster sugar
- ½ cup cocoa powder
- ⅓ cup olive oil
- 1 tablespoon of balsamic vinegar
- 3 teaspoons of vanilla essence
- 1 ½ cups of water

Method

- Preheat oven to 170 degrees
- Grease a 20cm cake tin, and lightly dust with cocoa powder
- Sift dry ingredients into a bowl and stir
- Make a well in the middle and add wet ingredients
- Gently stir to smooth batter
- Bake for 50 minutes or until a skewer comes out clean
- Cool for 10 minutes
